- 2. The results presented in the abstract do not address the mediating and moderating effect to the IV and DV relationship.
- 3. Additional findings also do not properly address in the objective of study in the abstract.
- 4. Sentences were poorly constructed and the grammar also have serious problem. Professional editing is highly required for next revision.

Comments to the Corresponding Author

- 1. The paper has not presented the real problem regarding the corruption evidence in Indonesia. I have the opinion that the data or information regarding the corruption evidence will give a strong reason for writing this paper.
- 2. The paper exposes the summary of the results of the analysis in the introduction, which is uncommon in the academic paper/article. I recommend the author to consider revising this presentation.
- 3. Please recheck the probability p=0.872 or 0.0872? (Page 10, line 11 and 24)
- 4. On page 11, line 7, the author state about the previous research, but it lacks explanantion what the content of the previous research.
